Command Sergeant Major Joseph T Quick

CSM Quick joined the Vermont National Guard with 3-172 IN MTN Unit in March of 1986. From 1987 to 2002 CSM Quick has held every leadership position to include, Team leader, Squad leader, Platoon Sergeant, Operations Sergeant and First Sergeant. In November of 2004 CSM Quick was selected as the Command Sergeant Major for 3-172 IN MTN. From 2008 to 2010 CSM Quick was assigned to the Army Mountain Warfare School as the Commandant. When the 86th IBCT deployed to Afghanistan, CSM Quick was selected to be the Rear Detachment Command Sergeant Major. Upon return of the 86th IBCT CSM Quick was selected in January of 2011 to be the 86th IBCT Command Sergeant Major.

CSM Quick was deployed in 2003 to Afghanistan to work with the Afghanistan National Army as an Embedded Training Team. While in Afghanistan CSM Quick worked in Mazere-Sharrif, Kabul, Herat and Kandahar. As the Command Sergeant Major of the 3-172 IN MTN, CSM Quick deployed every Company in his BN to either Iraqi Freedom or Operation Enduring Freedom. The most rewarding time for CSM Quick was when he was the Rear Detachment CSM and was able to assist and inform Families and Soldiers of the deployed Units. CSM Quick conducted Town Hall Meetings across the State at all Armories. These meetings were conducted in a three tier approach: Pre- deployment; informing and educating Families on what to do to prepare the household and finances. During deployment; to answer any questions of the Families and make sure they understood the OPSEC importance of deployments. The third tier was a month before the BDE came home, whereby we talked about Soldier issues that could occur within the first couple months after the Soldiers return. CSM Quick also helped create a Family Battle Drill book developed from the National Guard Resiliency book. Upon completion of the BDE deployment CSM Quick was in charge of tracking all the Wounded Warriors from the BDE. CSM Quick traveled to over 13 Warrior Transition Units and Medical Treatment Facilities to make sure no Soldier was forgotten or left behind. While working with the Wounded Warriors CSM Quick worked closely with the Family Readiness program of VT, the Outreach Program helping the Soldiers with behavior issues and VA benefits. The Family Assistance Coordinators (FAC) to make sure that the Soldiers Family members also received the assistance they needed.

I look forward to the opportunities to continue to serve the Soldiers and Families of the United States Army in any capacity possible.
